



# ***GOTTARDO CUP***

**TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**

**ENGLISH VERSION**



## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Gottardo Cup is a Tournament to signify and foster the co-operation between the Associations of ProBasket and Ticino Basket. It is also a tournament to help develop female basketball in both regions and provide a platform for competition and player development.

The 2024 format is a change from prior years, to have a one-day tournament of short, 14-minute games to permit more teams to compete, and to have a format whereby a winner by knock-out can be determined on the day.

The 2024 Tournament is hosted by Baar Bumble Bees Female Basketball Club of Baar, Zug on Saturday, 21<sup>st</sup> September.

An opening ceremony will take place at 9:15 am and the first games will start at 9:30am. Teams from Ticino will not be scheduled to play until the second game at 9:55 to permit for a later arrival. The Competition is expected to be concluded by circa 17:00.





## **2. GOTTARDO CUP 2024 FORMAT**

### **Competition Format – U14**

The Tournament consists of 10 teams. These are separated into two groups of 5 Teams.

Each team will play each other once within their Group.

Points are awarded 3 points for a win. 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss.

The top 2 teams of each Group then proceed to a Semi-Final and the winners of each will contest the final.

There are additional placing games as follows:

3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Play Off - Competed by the losers of the two Semi-Finals

5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Play Off - Competed by the teams which finish 3<sup>rd</sup> in each league

7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Play Off - Completed by the teams which finish 4<sup>th</sup> in each league.

9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> Play Off – Completed by the teams which finish 5<sup>th</sup> in each league.

### **Competition Format – U12**

The Tournament consists of 6 teams. These will complete in a single group of all 6 teams.

Each team will play each other once within the Group.

Points are awarded 3 points for a win. 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss.

The top 4 teams of the Group will then proceed to a Semi-Final and the winners of each will contest the final.

There is an additional placing game as follows:

3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Play Off - Competed by the losers of the two Semi-Finals

### **Location**

The competition will take place at Turnhalle Sternmatt II in Baar. Inwilerstrasse 22b, 6340 Baar.

Sternmatt II has 3 basketball Courts. (Halle 1, Halle 2 and Halle 3). The schedule of games will indicate which Halle.

The opening and closing ceremonies will all take place at Sternmatt II, Halle 2.

### **3. REGULATIONS**

#### **Reception**

With the exception of teams from Ticino, Teams should present themselves at Sternmatt II at the latest at 9:15 am for the opening ceremony. Teams travelling from Ticino are able to arrive later.

First games begin at 9:30am, and for teams from Ticino at 9.55am

#### **Licences**

All players are not required to be licenced with Swiss Basketball (as this is a Pre-Season Tournament) but are expected to be play in the correct age category.

#### **Teams**

A team can consist of up to a maximum of 12 female players within the correct age category.

#### **Baskets**

The hight of the baskets will be 3.05 meters.

#### **Balls**

U12: Number 5 balls will be used.

U14: Number 6 balls will be used.

#### **Periods**

1 x 14 minutes without break or pause.

#### **Table officials**

A match sheet is not kept. The points are counted by table officials using a scoreboard. The final result is recorded in writing and brought to the match table.

#### **Game Rules**

The following rules apply:





- Back pass
- System of alternating possession (arrow)
- 3 second and 5 second rule
- Free throws: U12: the small front marker applies  
U14: the free throw line applies
- Defence: Individual defence is mandatory!

**The following are not taken into account:**

- 8 second and 24 second rule
- Team fouls
- U12 blocking is prohibited
- U14 blocking is permitted

**Replacements**

Rolling changes are permitted during a break in play.

**Time Outs**

None

**Team Jerseys**

Due to limited time to change between games, if a colour clash is noted, one team will wear Coloured Bibs which will be provided.

**Tied Results – League Stage**

A tied result is permitted during the League Stage. Each team will receive 1 point to the League Points total.



### **Tied Results – Knock out stage or placing game.**

In the event of a tied game during the knock out stage or placing game an additional minute of game time will be played. If still no winner, a further minute will be played until a winner is determined.

### **Referees**

Referees are to be organised by ProBasket.

### **Table Officials**

Each team is responsible for providing 1 table official.

### **Trophies and Medals**

Players of the winning team, runner up and third place will each receive a Medal.

The Winning Teams of the U14 and U12 Competition will also receive a trophy. The “Gottardo” Trophy.



#### **4. Additional Information**

##### **Food**

A discounted pasta lunch will be available (further details separately). In addition, a paying Kisok will be open throughout the tournament. Payment can be made by cash or TWINT.

##### **Theft**

The tournament organiser cannot be held liable in the event of theft at the premises (Turnhalle, changing rooms etc).

##### **Accident**

The organiser does not insure participants in the event of an accident. Each person must be personally insured against accidents.

##### **Data Protection**

The organiser reserves the right to publish photos taken on the occasion of the event and to publish them on the relevant websites. At the express request of the person concerned, photos of he or her may be removed at any time.

##### **Disputes**

Any disputes are decided upon by the Tournament Committee. The decision made will be irrevocable.
